Medicines verification system: Estonian experience


In Estonia, the organisation for the verification of the authenticity of medicinal products is called REKS and the verification of packaging is therefore called "reksimine". Estonia's NMVO (REKS) is a small-scale organisation, with 2 people and a so-called "robot worker", or REK-IS, to manage alerts. The local robot allows certain alerts to be solved 24/7 and so the REKS employee does not have to intervene at all.

Performance indicators of the LZVS

Since the launch of the verification system in Latvia, the number of checked and decommissioned medicine packages has been gradually increasing each year. This is primarily due to two reasons – firstly, the first few years of the system's operation saw a gradual increase in the number of end users and an improved system use experience and quality. The second reason is the growth of the market and an increase in medicine consumption.

In 2023, a total of 107.8 million transactions were carried out in the LZVS, of which 28.8 million correspond to the decommissioning of medicine packages in Latvia as packages were supplied to citizens. This represents a 3% increase compared to 2022. In 2023, the proportion of alerts affecting end users in Latvia was only 0.01% on average – significantly less than in the early stages of the system's operation.



At the start of 2024, the total number of LZVS end users was 1193, comprising 820 pharmacies, 58 wholesalers, and 315 medical institutions.

European Medicines Verification System Operation

The European Medicines Verification System, operating since 2019 in accordance with the EU Directive and Delegated Regulation, is a comprehensive, pan-European system covering all EU and EEA countries, connecting 2,800 pharmaceutical companies, 4,000 wholesalers, 110,000 pharmacies and 6,000 hospital pharmacies online, including all Latvian end users.

In the first half of 2023, the number of transactions increased by 21% compared to 2022, reaching an average of 3.4 billion transactions per quarter. The number of uploaded packages has typically remained stable: 5.8 billion in the first half of 2023.

The General Assembly of LZVO approved the budget for 2024

On November 27, 2023, a General Assembly meeting of stakeholders of the Latvian Medicines Verification Organisation (LZVO) was held, where the strategy and budget for 2024 were approved. The General Assembly also approved the fixed annual flat fee for the year 2024 for the marketing authorisation holders (MAHs), including parallel importers and parallel distributors of medicines in the territory of Latvia.
